A Child's Right to Attend School

This is to notify you that my child has the right to attend school.

The 2008 Constitution of Ecuador guarantees my child the right to education, stating in Title II, Chapter 2, Section 5, Article 26, "Education is a right of persons throughout their lives and an unavoidable and mandatory duty of the State. It constitutes a priority area for public policymaking and state investment, the guarantee of equality and social inclusion and the indispensable condition for the good way of living. Persons, families and society have the right and responsibility to participate in education." Additionally, the 2008 Constitution of Ecuador guarantees my child the right to education without discrimination. Title I, Chapter 1, Article 3 lays out as one of the State's prime duties "Guaranteeing without any discrimination whatsoever the true possession of the rights set forth in the Constitution and in international instruments, especially the rights to education, health, food, social security and water for its inhabitants."

This is particularly relevant in the case of children under the age of 18. In the 1989 Convention on the Rights of the Child, Part 1, Article 2, recognizes education as a right of the child, making access to education an obligation of governments. Part 1, Article, Section 2 addresses non-discrimination and provides that "State Parties shall take all appropriate measures to ensure that the child is protected against all forms of discrimination or punishment on the basis of status, activities, expressed opinions, or beliefs of the child's parents, legal guardians, or family members."

Because inoculation is a health status and a choice by parents, non-inoculated children cannot be discriminated against and must be permitted to attend school. Violations of this legal right will be reported to relevant and proper authorities.

Opt-Out of a Vaccine Inoculation

This is to notify you that I have the right to opt-out of a vaccine inoculation. The Ecuadorean Constitution of 2008, Title II, Chapter 6, Article 66, Section 10 guarantees "The right to take free, responsible and informed decisions about one's health..." and Section 12 articulates that individuals have "The right to conscientious objection, which shall not undermine other rights or cause harm to persons or nature," and Title VII, Chapter 1, Section 2, Article 362, "Healthcare services...shall guarantee informed consent...".

Therefore, I do not consent to being inoculated. Violations of this legal right will be reported to relevant and proper authorities.

Legal Liability Notice for Vaccine-Related Injury

This liability notice serves as a declaration of liability to administrators of the COVID-19 vaccine (COVAX) when acting within the scope of their authorized activities. Vaccine administrators are part of the public healthcare system of Ecuador. Ecuador's 2008 Constitution, Title VII, Chapter 1, Section 2, Article 359. "The national health system shall be comprised of institutions, programs, policies, resources, actions, and players in health..." Therefore, under the provisions of the Constitution, Title II, Chapter 3, Section 9, Article 54, "Persons or entities that provide public services or produce or market consumer goods shall be held liable both civilly and criminally for the inadequate provision of the services, for poor quality of the product or when its conditions are not consistent with the advertising that was made or with the description provided. Persons shall be held liable for any malpractice in the exercise of their profession, craft or trade, especially practices that endanger the integrity or life of persons"

Title II, Chapter 3, Section 9, Article 52 protects users and consumers and provides that "Persons have the right to have goods and services of the highest quality and to choose them freely, as well as to accurate information that is not misleading with respect to their contents and characteristics. The law provides for quality control mechanisms and consumer defense procedures, as well as penalties for the infringement of these rights, reparation and compensation for defects, damages or poor quality of goods and services and for the interruption of public services not caused by acts of God or force majeure situations".

Under Ecuador's 2008 Constitution, as a government public health administrator of a potentially unsafe vaccine, you will be held civilly and/or criminally liable for any injury or harm caused or resulting from COVAX.

The Right to be Free From Discrimination Based on Health Status

This is to notify you that I have the right to be free from discrimination that may result in the diminishment or annulment of recognition, enjoyment or exercise of my rights. Ecuador's Constitution disallows discriminatory practices based on health. Title II, Chapter 1, Article 11, Subsection 2 further adds that "No one shall be discriminated against for reasons of...health status...whether personal or collective, temporary or permanent, which might be aimed at or result in the diminishment or annulment of recognition, enjoyment or exercise of rights." Under this provision, individuals cannot be discriminated against based on health status. Inoculated and non-inoculated are health statuses and therefore individuals cannot be treated differently based on their decision to decline a vaccine. Again, Title I, Chapter 1, Article 3 lays out as one of the State's prime duties "Guaranteeing without any discrimination whatsoever the true possession of the rights set forth in the Constitution and in international instruments, especially the rights to education, health, food, social security and water for its inhabitants."

Violations of this legal right will be reported to relevant and proper authorities.
